

HAMAM TOWELS

Design: Lankava, Mia Lehtiniemi

Size: Hand towel 56x85 cm (bath towel 76x175 cm).

Structure: Plain weave

Warp per m: 85 (110) g Bockens Cottolin (60% cotton / 40% linen, tex 80x2, 250 g=1500 m): ¼-bleached (2000).

- Width in the reed: 60 (80.2) cm
- Sett: 8 ends per cm
- 2 per dent in a 40-dent reed
- 480 (642) ends total

Weft per towel: 20 (30) g Bockens Cottolin: ¼-bleached (2000) or ½- bleached (2001) and 65 (190) g peach (2075), blue-green (2032) or light green (2039).

Sett: 8 picks per cm

Instructions: Weave 90 (180) cm long towels using white and colored weft. Weave the stripes in the ends of the towels in the following color order: 12 (15) cm colored picks, 10 picks (2 cm) white, 10 picks (2 cm) colored, 5 (10) cm white picks, 10 picks (2 cm) colored, 10 picks (2 cm) white and 46 (114) cm colored picks in the middle section.

Mirror the color order at the end of the towel. Leave 30 cm of unwoven warp for fringe.

Finishing: Cut apart the pieces in the middle of the allowance for the fringe. Prepare a twisted fringe with 3+3 ends in each fringe. Trim the fringes below the knots.
