

## KNIT STITCH BASKET

**Design:** Lankava, Mirka Korpela.

**Size:** 26 x 17 cm (diameter x height).

**Yarn:** Lankava Paulina Chunky Twine (80 % recycled cotton, 20 % polyester, 1 kg = 170 – 180 m) 800 g petrol (80), lavender (85), yellow (57) or chalk pink (89).

**Other supplies:** Round plywood basket base 25 cm (57 holes) and removable stitch marker.

**Crochet hook:** 4 mm and 8 mm, or size to obtain gauge.

**Gauge:** 7 ns ja 8 krs = 10 cm.

**Abbreviations:** *rnd(s)* = round(s), *sc* = single crochet, *ss* = slip stitch, *st(s)* = stitch, *ws* = waistcoat stitch.

**Instructions:** The basket is crocheted in one piece from the plywood bottom to the top edge.

First, edge the plywood bottom using the smaller hook as follows: Insert the hook through a hole, catch yarn on the hook and draw through, again, catch yarn on the hook and draw through the st on the hook. Continue by crocheting 1 sc into each hole at the same time hiding the yarn end inside the sts. Switch to the larger hook and start working in the spiral.

**Rnd 1:** 1 ws into each st = 57 sts.

Continue working in the spiral. Mark the beginning of the round with a stitch marker and move the marker as the work progresses.

Repeat Rnd 1, 12 times more or until the height of the basket is 17 cm.

**Rnd 14:** Crochet 1 ss into each st. Cut yarn and weave the end in imitating the stitches.



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
